## General Appearance Rules

- Skirt length must be no more than 3cm below or above the knee.
- Ankle / knee length socks / tights **MUST** be worn with black leather fully polish-able shoes with functioning laces, buckles or straps and **MUST NOT** be worn with sandals.
- A plain black jacket or school polar fleece may be worn **AS WELL AS** the school jersey **NOT** instead of the school jersey and may not be worn in class.
- The only jewellery a student may wear is two studs in each ear, a wrist watch and a medic alert bracelet. Bracelets, rings, necklaces, anklets, facial studs of any kind are not permitted and will be confiscated without warning. They may not be disguised by plasters or clear plastic holders. Parents can collect confiscated jewellery at anytime. Tongue studs are discouraged. Students may be asked to remove these if obvious or visible.
- A student may wear a plain cross or taonga (greenstone or bone carving) next to their skin, out of sight.
- Makeup, if worn, should be a light touch and not noticeable.
- Only clear nail polish is permissible.
- Extreme hair styles and unusual hair colouring is not permitted.
- New and second hand uniform stocked at Anderson's.
